Medical Form: All campers are required to have an updated medical form on file from their pediatrician.

Fees: Rates are per session. A \$75 non-refundable deposit is required per child per session. The balance is due one week before the session starts.

Conditions: Children who are not members of FFTAC may not use the facility at other times. FFTAC reserves the right to cancel any summer sessions if a minimum number of children do not enroll, in which case FFTAC will refund the deposit money. FFTAC does not administer any medications to campers. Per Connecticut General Statutes, Connecticut Youth Athletic Camps are required to provide information on the signs, symptoms, nature and the risks of concussions.
